Migration is one of the most important global phenomena of the modern world, affecting economic, political, social, and cultural processes and giving rise to new phenomena and practices. Migration takes different shapes and forms. Some countries experience an outward flow of populations, while others undergo a large-scale inflow of migrants and refugees. What issues should scholars focus on today in order to understand migration on the local, national, or even continental scale? What methods need to be employed in such studies? How is migration to be understood in academic research, and what questions must be answered today?

The conference is geared towards an interdisciplinary approach. We have brought together experts from a variety of fields, including economics, sociology, political science, anthropology, and cultural studies. Among other issues, we are going to discuss the following themes:

new directions of migration;
transnational migration
forced migration;
ethnic entrepreneurship and transformation of urban space;
children of migrants and integration of migrants;
religion and migration.

The conference will include a roundtable ‘Adaptation of Migrants’ Children’, bringing together scholars and civil society activists to discuss problems of access to education for the children of migrants and issues of their adaptation in schools.
