



**DR. HEINZ RUDOLPH,** *Lead Financial Sector Economist, World Bank*

Heinz Rudolph is a Lead Financial Sector Specialist at the Finance and Markets Global Practice Sector of the World Bank. He has been with the World Bank for the past fourteen years. Funded pension systems and development bank institutions are his main areas of work. Mr. Rudolph worked as a consultant in more than twenty countries of Latin America, Europe and Asia regions. Between 1995 and 2004, he worked at the Ministry of Finance of Chile as a Director of Financial Policy, where he led technical work on financial sector reforms in the area of pensions, insurance, securities and banking. He also led the government debt management strategy. Mr. Rudolph received a PhD in economics from Georgetown University.
